In January 2023, the Program registered almost 434 thousand workers among the 3.9 thousand approved supplier companies, located in 660 cities, in 18 Brazilian states. These professionals are positively impacted by compliance with the labor legislation, with the guarantee of their rights and of health and safety conditions at work," added Lima.

Social role

Launched in September 2021, ModaComVerso is a movement led by ABVTEX, whose purpose is to educate the consumer so that he/she is aware of how clothes are produced and can demand transparency and responsible origin of the products from the brands. It brings together 17 major fashion

We seek to support consumers in their choices, valuing transparent fashion and the awareness of buying from brands that monitor their chain.
